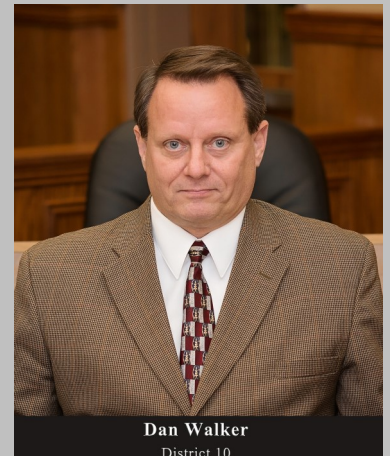
thankful for in our county and I wish everyone a wonderful and happy Thanksgiving.
