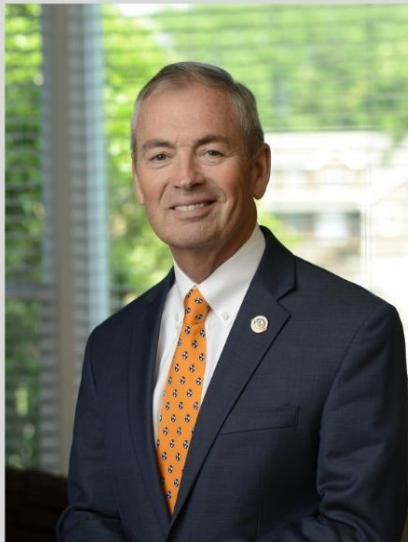

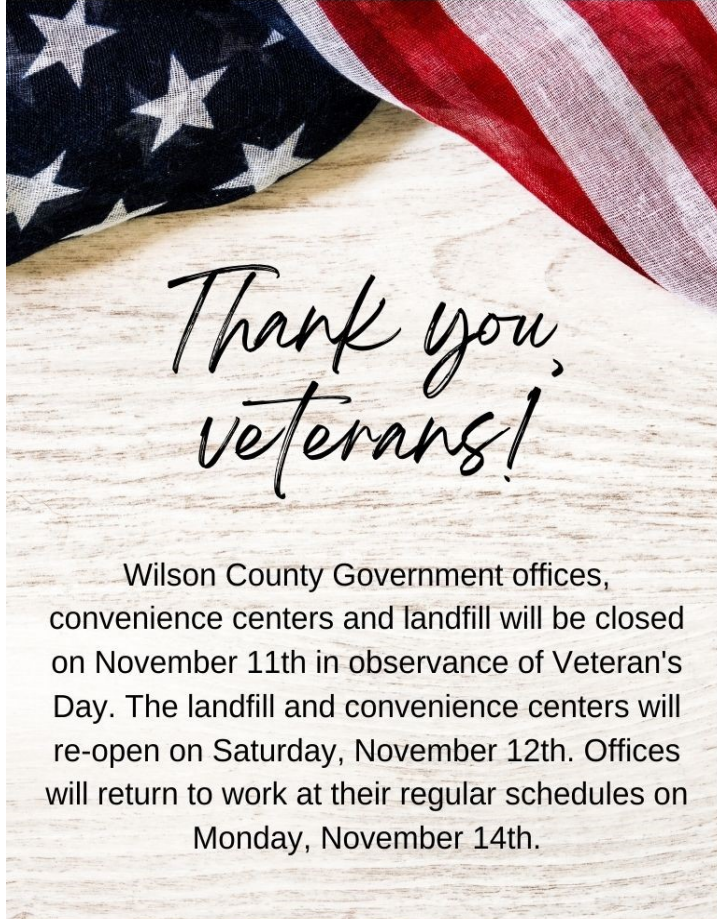

NEW BALANCE TO ESTABLISH DISTRIBUTION OPERATIONS IN LEBANON

Last month, it was announced that New Balance Athletics will establish a new distribution center in Lebanon, Tennessee. The company plans to invest \$68.5 million in the new automated processing facility, which will be approximately 350,000 square feet. It is said that this will create more than 150 new jobs in Wilson County, and it is expected to be completed in the late summer of 2023.

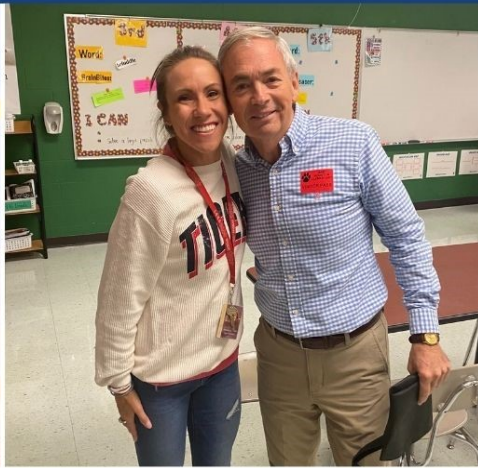

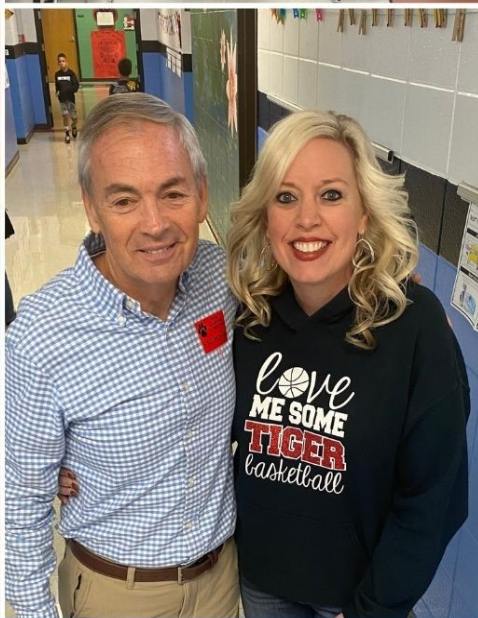

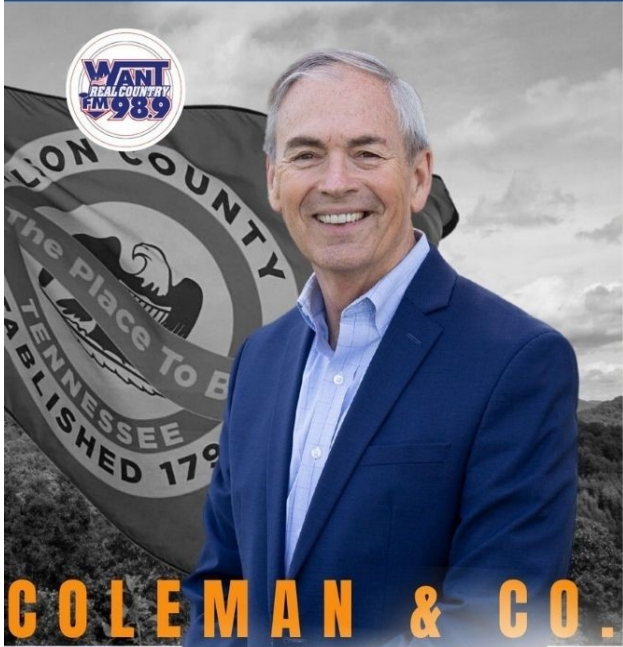

Including the USDA food allows us frequently to provide additional food that we don't always otherwise have available such as dairy items, fresh fruits and vegetables, and meats.

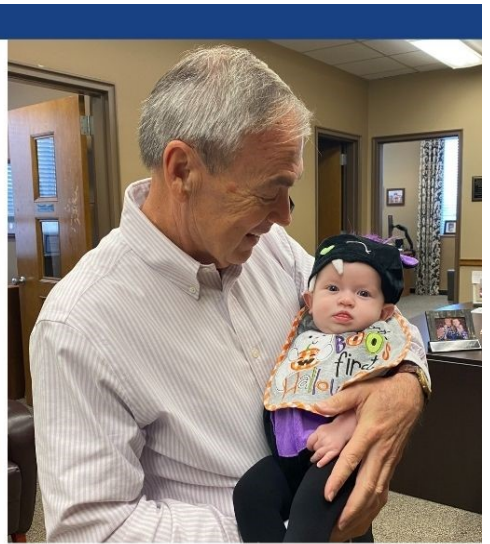
