

Due to the length of the Insurance Committee meeting, the meeting was moved to the County Commission meeting room. Those members present were Nancy Andrews, Dr. Chris McAteer and Commissioners Wendell Marlowe and Chad Barnard, being all the members of the Committee with the exception of Commissioner Jerry McFarland, who was absent. Also present was Animal Control Director Mary Scruggs, Assistant Animal Control Director Paula Heird, County Commissioner Terry Scruggs and County Attorney Legal Assistant Becky Fox.

Chairman Marlowe called the meeting to order and determined that a quorum was present.

The minutes of the November 5, 2015 and December 10, 2015 meetings were presented. Motion to approve both sets of minutes as printed was made by Commissioner Barnard, seconded by Nancy Andrews and carried unanimously.

Chairman Marlowe asked Animal Control Director Mary Scruggs to present the December 2015 Director's Report. Director Scruggs then reviewed the report with the Committee. Motion to approve the Animal Control Director's Report was made by Chairman Marlowe, seconded by Nancy Andrews and carried unanimously.

Chairman Marlowe asked Director Scruggs to update the Committee on the status of the building improvements at her facility. Painting is scheduled to be completed in the euthanasia and small cage rooms. Assistant Director Heird advised that there are a few spots in the kennel room that the paint is peeling off. They will contact Robert Baines about this issue.

Chairman Marlowe asked for an update on the new Animal Control vehicle. Director Scruggs advised that she was contacted today about what color she wanted for the vehicle. There is no console in this vehicle as it was originally supposed to be a police vehicle. There was no time frame quoted on when the vehicle would be ready for pick-up.

Director Scruggs advised that her department had already picked up 23 dogs since January 1, 2016. There continues to be a great rapport between her department and the Wilson County Sheriff's Department.

A representative of New Leash on Life advised the Committee that they had received a large dog grant and will be working in conjunction with Wilson County Animal Control to assist in the adoption of large dogs from their facility.

CABLE TV COMMITTEE MINUTES

The Cable TV Committee of the County Commission of Wilson County, Tennessee met in called session on Wednesday, January 13, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the upstairs Conference Room at the Wilson County Courthouse in Lebanon, Tennessee. Those members present were Commissioners Dan Walker, Frank Bush, Cindy Brown, Joy Bishop and Bobby Franklin, being all the members of the Committee. Also present were County Commissioner Sue Vanatta, Finance Director Aaron Maynard, County Planner Tom Brashear and County Attorney Michael R. Jennings.

Chairman Walker called the meeting to order and determined that a quorum was present.

The minutes of the December 8, 2015 meeting were presented. Motion to approve the minutes as printed was made by Commissioner Bush, seconded by Commissioner Franklin and carried unanimously.

An agenda had been prepared for consideration. The Committee first considered the pending issue with Charter Cable in Kensington Subdivision. Chairman Walker advised that Charter Communications has allocated funds to complete this sometime during calendar year 2016. Commissioner Vanatta advised that Nick Pavlis had informed her it would be completed within the 1st quarter of 2016. As this was verbal, Chairman Walker will e-mail Nick Pavlis to obtain written confirmation. Mr. Pavlis has requested that there be no public announcement of the work they are doing in Kensington. Chairman Walker appreciates what Charter has done. They "stepped up" and he would like to give credit where credit is due. Finance Director Maynard suggested having Nick Pavlis approve what we finally release to the press. Tom Brashear noted that it is important to advise about the 811 service "Call Before You Dig". After further discussion, motion to go with a public announcement on 811 with a generic preference to the problem that was solved by Charter Communications was made by Commissioner Brown, seconded by Commissioner Bishop and carried unanimously.

The Committee next considered the complaint received about a Davidson County franchise fee paid in the west end of Wilson County. Finance Director Maynard advised that he had been unsuccessful in reaching Randy Sanders to discuss the possibility of an audit being done on the franchise fees being paid. He would like to better understand the service issue because that appears to be the root of the issue. After some discussion, Chairman Walker suggested that this issue be left open tonight. Chairman Walker did advise of information received from Representative Mark Pody that Tim Schwarz is the Chief of Communications for the Tennessee Regulatory Agency and a potential source of information.

next to be considered was a discussion with the County Planner on cable provider commitments in county subdivisions. Chairman Walker asked Commissioner Franklin to identify the issue he talked about AT a previous meeting. Commissioner Franklin asked "Is it feasible to make access to cable t.v. part of the subdivision process?". Putting this in the subdivision regulations comes to mind.

County Planner Brashear advised OF a couple of potential problems. First, are the existing planning regions for the cities. Most subdivisions are in the City of Lebanon or City of Mt. Juliet planning region and we do not have the authority over that. The second potential issue is that cable t.v. may not be an essential service such as electricity, gas, water, etc. Most of the items that are essential services are public utilities. Much discussion was held on this issue.

Commissioner Franklin noted that the cities have lost a lot of the encouragement to provide infrastructure to areas out in the county for future annexation because of the change in the annexation laws. "This is a problem".

County Attorney Jennings asked if it would be feasible to have the cable t.v. providers partner with us in helping to provide a potential solution to these issues. As a part of this discussion, Commissioner Bush asked "Can we incentivize this?". Chairman Walker commented that Nick Pavlis had mentioned to him that the "pole fee" for cable providers in this area is higher than many areas. County Attorney Jennings suggested using Nick Pavlis as a resource to address the issue. The Committee noted the rapid increase in the need to provide data services to the outlying areas of the county. The enabling statutes for planning were passed at a time when the provision of data services was not nearly as prevalent as it is now. Chairman Walker is going to have some further discussions with Nick Pavlis on these issues. After further discussion, motion to have the County Attorney ask Senator Beavers, Representative Lynn and Representative Pody to provide copies of any specific proposed legislation for data and broadband services during this legislative session was made by Chairman Walker, seconded by Commissioner Franklin and carried unanimously.

The Committee next reviewed the Quarterly Cable Provider Service Reports filed with the State of Tennessee. Those reports that had been obtained were for the calendar years 2009 and 2010. Commissioner Bush asked "What happened at the end of 2010? Was the regulation changed? Was this at one time required quarterly? Is it still required?". Chairman Walker posed the question "Who dropped the ball?". He will talk to Jim Schwarz about the history of these reports and the current status of them.

As new business, Chairman Walker asked Finance Director Maynard about the number of providers we are receiving money from in our budget. Director Maynard advised of several that we are receiving ^{from} yet there appear to be only two county franchise agreements. Chairman Walker asked "What about the other providers we get revenue from? What agreements are they working from?".

Also, as new business, Chairman Walker advised of the website for the TRA. On this website is a hotline where complaints can be registered.

Chairman Walker also advised that Russell E. Byrd is the contact person for Comcast, similar to what Nick Pavlis does for Charter Communications.

The Committee determined that they would next meet on Tuesday, February 9, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the Committee on motion of Commissioner Bush, seconded by Commissioner Franklin, the Committee voted unanimously to adjourn.

INSURANCE COMMITTEE MINUTES

The Insurance Committee of the County Commission of Wilson County, Tennessee met in called session on Thursday, January 14, 2016 at 4:30 p.m. in the upstairs Conference Room at the Wilson County Courthouse in Lebanon, Tennessee. Those members present were Commissioners Sue Vanatta, Gary Keith, John Gentry, Terry Ashe and Jerry McFarland, being all the members of the Committee. Also present was Finance Director Aaron Maynard, Benefits Manager Debbie Green-Fischer, County Mayor Randall Hutto, County Commissioners Diane Weathers, Joy Bishop, Terry Scruggs, Chad Barnard, Wendell Marlowe and Bobby Franklin; THW Insurance Representatives Rick Thorne and Jud Nave, Human Resources Director Von Barr and County Attorney Michael R. Jennings.

Chairman Ashe called the meeting to order and determined that a quorum was present.

County Attorney Jennings led the Committee in prayer.

The minutes of the December 10, 2015 meeting were presented. Motion to approve the minutes as printed was made by Commissioner McFarland, seconded by Commissioner Vanatta and carried unanimously.

Chairman Ashe asked Finance Director Maynard to comment on the office restructure. Director Maynard stated it is "going fantastic"; getting fresh eyes on things is good. Debbie Green-Fischer and her staff members Holly and Jennifer are doing a great job. You may have noticed some construction going on in our office. That is being done so that all will be in the same area.

Director Maynard then gave an update on insurance expenditures through December. Commissioner McFarland asked Director Maynard to project expenditures to the end of the fiscal year. Director Maynard believes that we could be \$1 to \$1.5 million dollars short. But he did note that none of the savings mechanisms are being reflected yet because they begin on January 1, 2016. Also there will be some savings from the employees paying for dental insurance as opposed to the county.

Chairman Ashe discussed the possibility of an Employee Health Insurance Committee similar to what is done for Workers Compensation. Do we want to do this like we do workers compensation? Commissioner McFarland is in favor of this. He would also like to see a newsletter issued. Debbie Green-Fischer asked if the same committee could be used. After some discussion, motion to do a newsletter was made by Commissioner McFarland, seconded by Commissioner Vanatta. Commissioner Vanatta asked if this could be done by e-mail. A brief discussion was held. The motion then carried unanimously.

Chairman Ashe asked Rick Thorne and Jud Nave to give a THW Insurance update. Jud Nave distributed a handout. Rick Thorne explained the contents of the handout. During this time, Commissioner Vanatta had to leave the meeting. There was much discussion about high deductible health plans and health savings accounts. The response was given that health savings accounts amounts can accumulate and roll over into the next year.

Chairman Ashe then asked the Committee to discuss the employment agreement with Health Resource Integration, LLC. Chairman Ashe believes that we may need to revisit this contract, since it is now 3.5 years old. Some recommendations for modification may need to be made. The clinic is working but some things have developed over the 3.5 year period that are not in the contract. Director Maynard suggested that we look at the scope of services.

Sheena Sloan of Health Resource Integration, LLC reported to the Committee that there were 557 appointments in December. In response to the Committee's request, they will be increasing the clinic hours each Tuesday beginning in February from 9 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. They will watch this and see how it works. Everything else is working well.

Chairman Ashe asked about employees missing appointments at the clinic. Last month there were 12 to 15 who didn't cancel their appointments. As Ms. Sloan noted, because they did not cancel, other employees lost potential slots. They are discussing sending warning letters to these who don't cancel their appointments.

Sheena Sloan advised the Committee that the cost of the clinic has not increased but there has been a 18% increase in employees in the county during the last 3.5 years. The cost per patient, including labs and pharmacy, is \$57.81. Chairman Ashe suggested that the letter about missing appointments be sent. A discussion was held about how firm the letter should be.

As old business, Commissioner Gentry would like to see the action taken at the December 10, 2015 meeting concerning terminating the policy which allows married couples when both spouses are employed by the county to avoid paying for dependent insurance be placed in resolution form. After some discussion, motion to put this policy adopted by the Committee at its last meeting, to be effective with the new enrollment period at the end of calendar year 2016, to apply to married couples who both work for the county and who have children was made by Commissioner Gentry, seconded by Commissioner McFarland and carried by a vote of 4 for with one absent.

As new business, Commissioner McFarland commented that he believes it is the right thing for us to do a work session on the clinic. Also, the start of the next fiscal year is only six months away and this Committee needs to start thinking about what we need to do to address Finance Director Maynard's concerns.

Commissioner Gentry would like to see the work session include a discussion on health savings accounts. Chairman Ashe believes that any work session should be held during regular business hours so that employees are not being paid overtime for attending the nighttime meetings.

There being no further business to come before the Committee on motion of Commissioner McFarland, seconded by Commissioner Gentry, the Committee voted unanimously to adjourn.

Also present was Finance Director Aaron Maynard, County Commissioners Joy Bishop, Diane Weathers, Jerry McFarland, Terry Scruggs, Bobby Franklin, Chad Barnard, Annette Stafford and Sonja Robinson; and County Attorney Michael R. Jennings.

Chairman Keith called the meeting to order and determined that a quorum was present.

The minutes of the June 15, 2015 meeting were presented. Motion to approve the minutes as printed was made by Commissioner Gentry, seconded by Commissioner Glover and carried unanimously.

Jeff Dickson presented a Governmental Grant Contract for the county from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration in the amount of \$20,000. These are pass-through dollars and there is no county match. The grant is a "fee for service" grant. He would like a motion to approve the grant as money will be coming in shortly and the Trustee needs to know what to do with the money. The funds coming in from this grant will offset expenses already budgeted. Motion to accept this grant was made by Commissioner Glover, seconded by Commissioner Gentry and carried unanimously.

Chief Judicial Commissioner Randy Hankins appeared before the Committee. He first distributed a photograph of his office. He is seeking an appropriation from the Courtroom Security budget to pay for bulletproof glass for the window in the Judicial Commissioner's Office. Everything else has protection, but this window is unprotected. The cost of the bulletproof window will be \$2,192.17. Motion to recommend this budget amendment request to the Budget Committee was made by Commissioner Gentry, seconded by Commissioner Glover and carried unanimously.

Probation Services Director Betsy Jakalski appeared before the Committee to give a report on Probation Services. She distributed a handout entitled "Wilson County Probation Services January 14, 2016". A copy of this handout will be attached to these minutes and incorporated herein by reference. She first thanked the Judicial Committee for all they have given her department. She then discussed the contents of the handout with the Committee.

Director Jakalski advised the Committee that she has applied for State licensure for a new DUI school. She hopes that it will begin in 2016. There will be no additional cost to the county.

Chairman Keith advised Director Jakalski that Judge Haywood Barry had been very complimentary of her program.

There being no further business to come before the Committee on motion of Commissioner Gentry, seconded by Commissioner Glover, the Committee voted unanimously to adjourn.

URBAN TYPE PUBLIC FACILITIES BOARD MINUTES

The Urban Type Public Facilities Board of the County Commission of Wilson County, Tennessee met in regular session on Friday, January 8, 2016 at the conclusion of the Wilson County Road Commission meeting at the office of the Wilson County Road Commission, the Steve Armistead Building, at 1000 Tennessee Boulevard in Lebanon, Tennessee. Those members present were County Mayor Randall Hutto and Commissioners Jeff Joines, Terry Scruggs and Becky Siever, being all the members of the Board with the exception of Commissioner Kenneth Reich, who was absent. Also present was Finance Director Aaron Maynard, Landfill Superintendent Cindy Lynch, Stormwater Director James Vaden and County Attorney Michael R. Jennings.

Chairman Hutto called the meeting to order and determined that a quorum was present.

The minutes of the December 4, 2015 meeting were presented. Motion to approve the minutes as printed was made by Commissioner Joines, seconded by Commissioner Scruggs and carried unanimously.

There were no delegations to appear before the Board with regard to Solid Waste.

County Attorney Jennings advised that there was no Legal Report.

Landfill Superintendent Cindy Lynch gave the Solid Waste Report. In landfill activity, 5,421 cubic yards were hauled, up approximately 1,200 cubic yards over December, 2014. Revenue was \$48,785.46, up approximately \$11,000. Year-to-date revenue is \$282,484.26, up approximately \$41,000.

In collections and hauling, 1,555.76 tons were collected and hauled to either Smith County or recycled. These figures are similar to December, 2014. There was an increase in "bulky" items. This may be an indication that people were purchasing larger items during the Christmas season. 3,450 cubic yards were hauled to the Class III/IV Landfill, up approximately 650 yards over the same period of time a year ago. Tipping fees totaled \$70,143. 252.66 tons were recycled, about the same as the December, 2014 period. Recycling revenue was \$11,865.72, down approximately \$6,000.

There were 329 pulls from the convenience centers during the month of December. One day, last weekend, we totally ran out of boxes. We need to consider the purchase of some new boxes at budget time.

Superintendent Lynch would also like to consider the purchase of a backhoe at budget time. This will be purchased from Fund 207. The current backhoe is a 1991 model and we can no longer obtain parts for it.

Motion to approve the Landfill Superintendent's Report was made by Commissioner Joines, seconded by Commissioner Scruggs and carried unanimously.

There was no new business to come before the Board with regard to Solid Waste.

There was no old business to come before the Board with regard to Solid Waste.

The Board then turned its attention to Stormwater issues.

Director James Vaden distributed a two page Stormwater Director's Report. He went over the December inspections and review numbers with the Board.

Director Vaden discussed the contents of the "Work Summary" with the Board and distributed copies of the "Municipal Pollution Prevention Plan" for both the Wilson County Transportation Department Facility and the Road Commission garage. This is required by our MS-IV permit. The deadline was March 6, 2016 and we have met that. Next to be done is a training class for county employees.

Director Vaden advised that the mapping of all outfalls has been completed per the TDEC requirement.

Motion to approve the Stormwater Director's Report was made by Commissioner Siever, second by Commissioner Scruggs and carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Board on motion of Commissioner Siever, seconded by Commissioner Joines, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

BUDGET COMMITTEE MINUTES

The Budget Committee of the County Commission of Wilson County, Tennessee met in regular session on Thursday, January 14, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the upstairs Conference Room at the Wilson County Courthouse in Lebanon, Tennessee. Those members present were County Mayor Randall Hutto and County Commissioners Annette Stafford, Gary Keith and Jerry McFarland, being all the members of the Committee with the exception of Chairman Mike Justice, who was absent. Also present was Finance Director Aaron Maynard, County Commissioners Terry Scruggs, Bobby Franklin, Diane Weathers, Joy Bishop, Sonja Robinson and Jeff Joines, School Board Chairman Larry Tomlinson and County Attorney Michael R. Jennings.

In the absence of Chairman Justice, Vice Chairman McFarland called the meeting to order and determined that a quorum was present.

The minutes of the December 10, 2015 meeting were presented. Motion to approve these minutes as printed was made by Commissioner Keith, seconded by Commissioner Stafford and carried unanimously.

Finance Director Maynard gave the Financial Report. We are about where we should be at this point in the year. We are "on pace". Director Maynard called attention to Fund 151 and the strong growth in the Adequate Facilities Tax. Motion to approve the Financial Report was made by Mayor Hutto, seconded by Commissioner Keith and carried unanimously.

Commissioner McFarland asked if, and if so, how the Adequate Facilities Tax could be increased or decreased. He asked County Attorney Jennings to look into this.

Robert Baines presented a budget amendment request for County Buildings. He noted this budget amendment had changed a little from the amendment previously approved by the Public Works Committee. He explained that he had taken over two new WEMA stations this year, as well as the Veterans Park, and additional repairs and expenses. Motion to recommend approval of this budget amendment request to the County Commission subject to the approval of the Public Works Committee was made by Mayor Hutto, seconded by Commissioner Keith and carried unanimously.

Chief Judicial Commissioner Randy Hankins presented a budget amendment request for Courtroom Security. He explained the need for a bulletproof window in the Judicial Commissioner's office. This is a Level 4 window at a cost of \$2,192.17. Motion to recommend this budget amendment request to the County Commission was made by Commissioner Keith, seconded by Mayor Hutto and carried unanimously.

Finance Director Maynard presented a budget amendment request for Tourism. Motion to recommend this budget amendment request to the County Commission was made by Commissioner Stafford, seconded by Mayor Hutto and carried unanimously.

Finance Director Maynard presented a budget amendment request for the Ward Agricultural Center. This is out of the Ag Center Fund balance. Commissioner Jeff Joines further explained the need for the request and the money that will be recovered from reimbursement by the rodeo and projected sales. Motion to recommend this budget amendment request to the County Commission was made by Mayor Hutto, seconded by Commissioner Keith and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Stafford asked the Director of Schools to be requested to come to this Committee meeting each month to give a report.

Mayor Hutto reported that a workshop had been scheduled for the Tourism PILOT project by Lebanon Mayor Philip Craighead. He gave the date and time.

Vice Chairman McFarland called for public comment. Derek Dodson distributed a four page handout but did not speak on the handout.

Commissioner Bobby Franklin addressed the Committee. He reminded them of the adoption of Public Chapter 1101 in 1998 which had helped the counties a lot. It also provided for the cities to provide infrastructure and new annexation. Now, the annexation law has been changed, cities are not annexing. He urged the Committee to be careful when receiving requests for funding from the Adequate Facilities Tax. We might not want to spend this money for maintenance items because we may need these for new projects in the county since the cities cannot do the infrastructure.

There was no old business to come before the Committee.

There was no new business to come before the Committee.

There being no further business to come before the Committee on motion of Commissioner Stafford, seconded by Commissioner Keith, the Committee voted unanimously to adjourn.

WHEREAS, the Insurance Committee has determined that, effective with the next enrollment period, that portion of eligibility for the policy which allows married couples, when both spouses are employed by the County, and when they have dependent coverage, to avoid paying for dependent coverage shall be terminated and instead require one (1) spouse of the couple to pay the dependent insurance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Wilson County, Tennessee that we hereby amend the contract of insurance for partially self-funded medical coverage on behalf of Wilson County employees and dependents, as follows:

1. Beginning with the next enrollment period, the policy which previously allowed married couples, when both spouses are employed by the County, to avoid paying for dependent insurance coverage shall be terminated.

2. Beginning with the next enrollment period, for any married couple where both spouses are employed by the County and they have dependent insurance coverage, one (1) spouse of that couple shall be required to pay for the dependent insurance as required by any other County employee with dependent insurance.

Alesia Burnley announced the children's petting zoo scheduled for the Lebanon Library for October 6th has been cancelled. They are bringing in inflatables for the children instead from 10-12:00. Pam Wiggins noted "Chester the Chesapeake Lab", a dog used for therapy, will be at the Watertown Library. Nancy Armstrong noted the model train display will be shown, Thursday through Saturday.

Alesia Burnley reported a request for information regarding the retirement (TCRS) for the libraries was received from a county commissioner. A discussion was made about library employees being county employees. This topic arises every few years, but has yet to be resolved. Alesia Burnley noted the insurance premium is due on the buildings. There will be an increase in the deductible. She has spoken with Tony Shipp to see if there is a way to lower the premiums.

Alesia Burnley informed the board of a patron requesting a braille display. The board voted no due to limited space. She also requested direction in what to do with a few lost rings that had been collected over the years. No owners have come forward. One ring was a US Navy ring and she would like to check with the Veteran's office. On motion by Diane Weathers, seconded by Bettye Stone, the board gave permission for Alesia to sell the items.
