Resolution 16-7-5 Authorizing the Issuance of County District School Bonds of Wilson County, Tennessee in the Aggregate Principal Amount of Not to Exceed Two Million Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,450,000), in One or More Series; Making Provision for the Issuance Sale and Payment of Said Bonds; Establishing the Terms Thereof and the Disposition of Proceeds Therefrom; Providing for the Levy of Taxes for the Payment of Principal of, Premium, if any, and Interest on the Bonds. Passed 19 yes, 4 against (McFarland, Bush, Gentry, Brown), 2 Absent (Bannach & Emberton).

Resolution 16-7-6 Authorizing the Issuance of General Obligation School Bonds of Wilson County, Tennessee in the Aggregate Principal Amount of Not to Exceed Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$5,850,000), in One or More Series; Making Provision for the Issuance, Sale and Payment of Said Bonds; Establishing the Terms Thereof and the Disposition of Proceeds Therefrom; Providing or the Levy of Taxes for the Payment of Principal of, Premium, if any, and Interest on the Bonds. Passed 13 yes, 10 against (Franklin, McFarland, Bush, Walker, Gentry, Ashe, Weathers, Brown, Vanatta, Bishop) and 2 absent (Bannach & Emberton).
