Self-Contracting & Worker's Compensation Exemption Affidavit

As a property owner in Wilson County, you have the right to apply for a building permit to build and make improvements on your own property. In doing so, you become your own 'general contractor' and are personally responsible for the coordination of all phases of construction, workmanship, materials, and safety on the job-site for the duration of the permitted project. State law (T.C.A. 62-6-103) requires that you have a State of Tennessee General Contractor's License if you build any type of livable dwelling with the intent to sell or lease it at any time. If you do not possess said license, then you are **ONLY** allowed to build a livable dwelling that you yourself will live in. Additionally, as the property owner, you are exempt from the requirements of T.C.A. 13-7-211 if you do not possess a State of Tennessee General Contractor's License and wish to perform construction of any kind on your own personal property.
