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Changes Effective January 1, 2015:

All masonry foundation walls, 6' in height or in excess thereof, will be required to be of an engineered design. A stamped copy of an engineers' letter stating the foundation meets or exceeds code standards will be required to be on file for each job.

It is required, that no matter the height of *any* masonry wall which includes simple foundations, basements, porches, and retaining walls, having 4' or more of unbalanced backfill, are required to be of an engineered design. (Tables R404.1.1 (1) thru R404.1.2 (9)). Any walls exceeding the heights in the aforementioned tables *must be* of an engineered design. A stamped copy of an engineers' letter stating the foundation meets or exceeds code standards will be required to be on file for each job.

We will be changing to the 2009 energy code requirements. As will be required by the City of Lebanon, A notarized letter furnished by either the builder or installers stating the R-values and that the home meets or exceeds code requirements of the IECC will need to be on file prior to CO.
